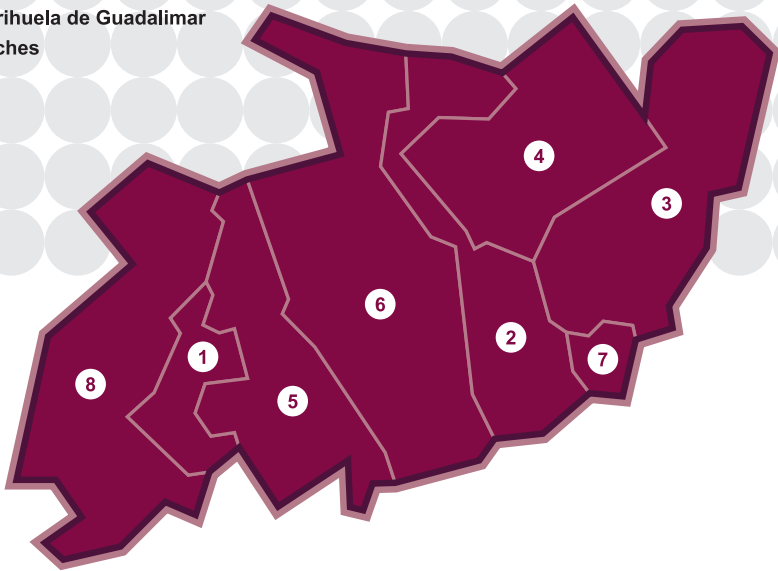

**T**he region of **El Condado**, in the north of the province of Jaén and sheltered by the Sierra Morena, offers a mosaic of very diverse and unique landscapes: red earth and olive groves, pastures, of holm oak forests, slopes and valleys of Mediterranean scrubland, watered by a number of streams, rivers and dams.

The County of Jaén accumulates centuries of border territory and crossroads that have left a varied heritage; from dinosaur footprints, cave art, Iberians, Roman bridges, cave houses, castles and towers, colonization villages, museums, inter-pretation centers, archaeological sites, churches, urban centers, winding and steep streets, historic centers of Arab origin; to modernist architecture, ... are some of the many suggestions to visit and get to know this region, noble for its origin and the hospitality of its inhabitants.

The County of Jaén is also a land of olive trees and olive oil, with a very varied olive oil heritage among olive mills, the Olive Oil and Olive Grove Interpretation Center in Navas de San Juan, olive wood craftsmanship; together with a rich gastronomy in which stand out dishes linked to olive oil, or the miller's breakfast. The wild bull in its nature is also a singular attraction and protagonist of the region.



# Olive trees, bulls and heritage

**19:30 h Option 1: Visit to the Dinosaur Footprints Natural Monument of Santisteban del Puerto.** Walk through its historic center declared of cultural interest, getting to know its castle, the church of Santa Maria, the Jacinto Higuera Museum or the viewpoint of "La Guarida". You can also visit the Interpretation Center of Condado de Santisteban.

**Option 2: Visit to the Dry Stone Constructions - World Heritage Site of Sorihuela del Guadalimar,** including a walk through the town center visiting its Arab tower and the Interpretation Center of the History of the Cuatro Villas.

**Option 3: Visit to the urban area of Montizón,** an example of a village of the Nuevas Poblaciones de Carlos III with its characteristic urban architecture. You can also visit its cemetery, one of the first civilian cemeteries in Spain.

### 17:30 Option 1: Visit to the wild bull ranch Finca El Vadillo, in Navas de San Juan.

Visit to the ranch accompanied by professionals:

- Young bull wrangling practices and demonstrations.

- Lodging in rural houses, country parties, leisure areas, space for events.

## Day 2

**10:00 h Option 1: Finca las Manillas Oil Mill, in Arquillos.** Guided visit of the oil mill, brief olive oil training at the Oil School, tasting of its products and physical and online sale.

**Option 2: Visit to Olivasur Natural Oil Mill** in El Porrosillo Arquillos. Complete visit including: talk, visit to the olive mill, olive grove and oil tasting.

**Option 3: Visit to Finca del Vizconde in Arquillos.** The world's smallest oil mill.

**Option 4:** Visit to one of the Interpretation Centers or Museums of “**CondadoJaén: Museum Territory**”.

**13:00 h Visit to the town of Arquillos,** an example of a Carlos III New Town, with its characteristic urban architecture, where its Underground Galleries, and its Pablo de Olavide and Carlos III New Town Interpretation Center stand out.

**14:30 h Lunch and visit of a wild bull ranch**

**Option 1: Finca El Añadío, bull tourism, in Vilches.**

- Horse-related activities: guided horse-riding, horse-drawn carriage rides, equestrian classroom, horse boarding and maintenance service, horse training and grooming, and hippotherapy.

- Group celebrations, country meals and flamenco parties, birdwatching, telescope for astrological observations, archery, outdoor barbecues, seasonal hunting and sightseeing.

- For groups, the farm has prepared a package consisting of a day at the ranch, lodging at the Añadío and hotels in neighboring areas, transfer to the farm, breakfast, country excursion in an all-terrain vehicle, visit to the livestock facilities, bullfighting with professionals, picnic lunch and transfer to the hotel.



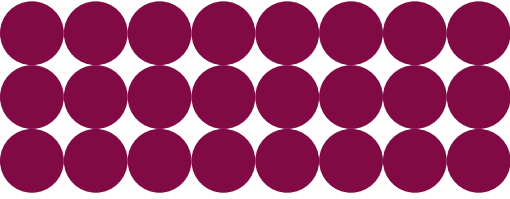
### Option 2: Visit to La Alcolehuela ranch, in Vilches

Finca located in the Sierra Morena, where you can disconnect and relax surrounded by hundreds of hectares of hills covered with oaks, wild olive trees and strawberry trees with total privacy.

## OLIVE OIL AND OLIVE GROVE INTERPRETATION CENTER

Located in a very well conditioned ecological park, on the outskirts of **Navas de San Juan** next to the road towards Santiesteban del Puerto. The park is open to the public, so the center can only be entered with authorization from the Town Hall and when tourist visits are scheduled. Guided tours of the park and the center are available.

It has posters on the process of exploitation of the olive grove and explanatory videos. Olive oil is the economic base of the region. The Interpretation Center serves to learn about the cultivation of olive trees and how olive oil is produced through material, audiovisual and other interactive tools.

By observing the elements that make up the Olive Oil and Olive Grove Interpretation Center, visitors can fully understand how olive oil is produced, from the cultivation of the olive grove and the harvesting of the olives to their final packaging, including, of course, the description of the process that takes place in the olive mill.

## LAS MANILLAS RANCH

It is located at the foot of Sierra Morena, between the towns of Andújar and Despeñaperros, in the town of **Arquillos**, in the region of El Condado de Jaén. Framed in a mountain olive grove divided in two parts: the old high olive grove plantation in the middle of the mountain range and the new olive grove area, which is outlined in the flatter part, with gentle hills.

The olive grove plantation of Finca Las Manillas is traditional in a frame of 11×11 meters in which each olive tree has three feet. It is irrigated throughout, ensuring regularity in production and quality in each season. At Finca las Manillas the best olives are selected to obtain extra virgin olive oil. In the mill, only home-grown olive oil is produced, mostly of the picual and arbequina varieties under the brands Noviembre and Las Manillas, where the operations carried out to obtain the EVOO comply with the differentiated quality systems.

- In **Vilches**, about the Fort City of Giribaile.
- In **Castellar**, dedicated to the Iberian Sanctuary of Cueva de la Lobera.
- In **Sorihuela del Guadalimar**, to its history and that of the Four Towns.
- In **Chiclana de Segura**, to the medieval poet Jorge Manrique.
- In **Arquillos**, to Pablo de Olavide and the New Towns of Sierra Morena.
- In **Navas de San Juan**, to olive oil and olive groves.
- En **Montizón**, to the ecosystems of El Condado of Jaén.

## THE IBERIAN COUNTY

A journey to the time of the Iberians in El Condado de Jaén: the Fortified City of Giribaile in Vilches and the magical Iberian sanctuary of La Cueva de la Lobera in Castellar will take you to know an advanced civilization full of Iberian princes, dramas, goddesses, warriors and votive offerings that left an extraordinary archaeological heritage during seven centuries of history.



### Archaeological Site and Interpretation Center of the Fortified City of Giribaile

Giribaile is considered one of the most important archaeological sites in Spain. In this natural site of special beauty can be seen from the remains of the primitive Iberian settlement, to the curiosity of its many caves carved into rock that are spread over the slopes of the hill and, undoubtedly, its medieval fortress, built in the ninth century by the Arabs whose remains are visible from many miles around.

The traveler will be able to see the remains that still remain of the great wall that surrounded the Iberian oppidum, an important city that occupied a strategic place in the connection route between Castulo and the Levant and that was abandoned after being razed by the Romans.

In the archaeological enclave you can visit, booking in advance by phone, a sanctuary, an Iberian settlement, a Paleochristian or Visigothic monastery or hermitage and an Almohad castle, all surrounded by beautiful landscapes between olive groves and mountains. Landscape, culture, heritage, history, nature, hiking... are intermingled in Giribaile, where it is possible to appreciate the mark left by different peoples and cultures over the centuries.

## Iberian Sanctuary of Cueva de la Lobera and Museum of Iberian Art in Castellar



Located one kilometer from Castellar, on a rocky ledge in what is known as the Altos del Sotillo, it is an emblematic settlement of Iberian archaeology that was founded in the mid-fourth century BC and remained in use uninterruptedly until the second century AD.

The Sanctuary is an open-air worship space, associated with different shelters and caves, and is built on a rocky ledge, taking advantage of 3 natural caves, with niches between them, the largest, called the Cavern of the Idol and the central core of the sanctuary constituted by the famous Cave of La Lobera.

This sanctuary was discovered because of the Iberian bronze votive offerings that had been circulating and treasured in private collections since the 19th century. The interest in the so-called "mingos" caused it to be

illegally exploited throughout much of the twentieth century. Since 1912 it was the object of interventions aimed at its conservation and in these first actions the Cueva de La Lobera was frequented by scholars moved by such a rich archaeological heritage.

Already in the urban center of Castellar, located inside a 16th century keep, known as Pallarés Castle, we can visit the Iberian Museum (also known as the Museum of the Iberian Exvoto, unique in Spain for its subject matter.

Through its rooms we can discover how the votive offerings were made, what meaning they had for the Iberians, what their vision of the afterlife was like and their relationship with the gods.

A magnificent collection of these figurines that still keep in their faces the mystery of the people they represented and that are a reference for both fans and scholars of the subject of offerings and beliefs in the Iberian world.

## DRY STONE CONSTRUCTIONS - UNESCO IMMATERIAL CULTURAL HERITAGE



Limestone, very abundant in the municipalities of Navas de San Juan and Sorihuela del Guadalimar, has always been very present in a wide range of traditional dry stone constructions, such as threshing floors, huts, barricades, cairns, fences, and other constructions of great ethnological and historical value.

These constructions have a very ancient origin, at least from the Neolithic period,

and their building has continued up to the present day, as a traditional architecture that constitutes one of the most significant cultural expressions of rural areas, a product of the activity of its people, especially in agriculture and livestock, and of the climatic and geographical conditions of the area.

These types of constructions are in danger of disappearing because they have lost the functionality they had in the past, so many are in ruins or are falling into ruin and collapsing as they are abandoned. The inclusion, by UNESCO, of the knowledge and techniques of the art of building dry stone walls in the Representative List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity has given a definitive boost to the conservation of this ethnographic heritage.

These are dwellings which are commonly known in the town as "Caracoles" and "Chozos".

In Navas de San Juan we can find them in the places of La Loma del Pino, La Covatilla, Los Membrillos, Los Corralillos, Cañá de los Vuelos and Cetrina el Viejo.

In Sorihuela del Guadalimar we find the Chozo de Tocinillo and in the place of Vista Alegre: Chozo Juanico, Chozo de la Cerca, Chozo de los Lunares and Chozo de Pitiminí.

## FIGHTING BULL RANCH

### Condado, Bull Territory

Extensive pastures make up the landscape of the Comarca de El Condado, an ideal environment where the breeding of fighting bulls takes place. There are many people who love this world and for this reason the region offers a wide range of activities, which will provide visitors a different and unforgettable day in an incomparable setting.



### El Añadío



**Finca El Añadío** is a 350-hectare pasture located on the slopes of Sierra Morena, where since the mid-nineteenth century, successive generations of the same family have been dedicated to the breeding of the fighting bull. You will be able to live with the Santa Coloma bulls in their natural habitat and you will have the opportunity to learn from the inside about the activities of this type of farm and the use of its livestock facilities: enclosures, corrals, bullfighting ring and wharfs.

You will be able to stay on the farm itself, in rehabilitated dwellings, the former homes of the farm's foremen and cowboys.

El Añadio offers a wide range of activities:

- Bullfighting activities (bullfighting classroom, guided visit to the cattle ranch in 4x4 vehicles, practical bullfighting classes and practical training on cattle operations).
- Equestrian activities (horseback riding with instructor, horse-drawn carriage rides, equestrian classroom).
- Activities in nature (rural cycling, hiking, 4x4 routes, excursions in the pasture, canoeing and fishing, painting and craft exhibitions, complete gymkhanas for companies, celebrations for groups with picnic and flamenco party, ornithological observations, telescope for astrological observations, archery, preparation of outdoor barbecues, seasonal hunts, and sightseeing tours).
