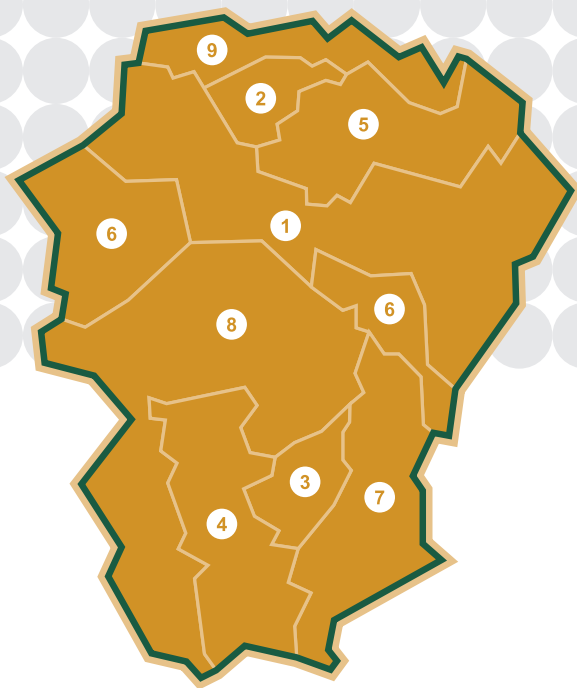

The **Sierra de Cazorla** region is located in the southeast of the province of Jaén. Numerous villages and farmhouses are distributed throughout its geography, crowned by the ranges of Cazorla, Quesada, el Pozo and La Cabrilla.

Due to its natural values, it is a Biosphere Reserve, Natura Network and other environmental protection figures such as ZEPA, LIC and ZEC. It is a member of the European Charter for Sustainable Tourism, as well as being a SICTED destination (Integral System of Tourist Quality in Destination). The olive grove landscape is an essential part of its personality, its identity and its history.

Its high average altitude, over 1,000 m, and its numerous peaks that exceed 2,000 m, give it great beauty and uniqueness, with a rugged landscape and very varied ecosystems. All this makes the Sierra de Cazorla a paradise for hiking, active tourism and ecotourism, with a great connection to the figure of Felix Rodriguez de la Fuente.

Its cuisine is defined by its mountain character and the products of the environment: game meats, fish, and fresh vegetables, without missing its excellent EVOO with "Sierra de Cazorla" D.O.

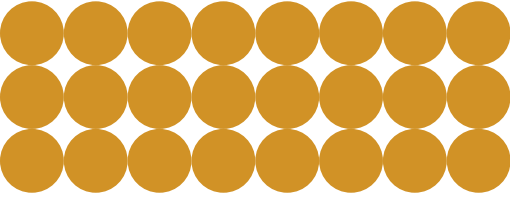

LA ALMEDINA OIL MILL

The mill is located in a nineteenth century farmhouse, located an 8 minutes drive from the town of Cazorla. In it you can learn about the whole process of olive oil production; the different ways of storing the olive juice, from ancient earthenware jars to an iron tank, to the stainless steel tanks that are used today.

It has several unique and very well preserved traditional tools and implements. Located in a privileged ecological enclave in the Sierra de Cazorla, Segura and Las Villas Natural Park, La Almedina de Cazorla is a complex of historic buildings known as the Palace of the Marquis of Foronda. The complex houses the palace dwelling, a historic oil mill and a modern mill, where extra virgin olive oil is produced, the Torreón de Nubla.

Activity program:

- Visit to the palace - oil mill, with its cultural, artistic and traditional heritage.
- Visit to the factory and deposits to get to know the whole oil elaboration process.
- Brief guided tour of the olive grove.
- Tasting room and store.

Length: approximately 3 hours (1h tour of the palace, 30' tour of the elaboration process, 30' coffee break, 1h visit to the olvie grove, tasting and store).

SIERRA DE CAZORLA HOTEL & SPA

The Sierra de Cazorla Hotel and Spa is located on the access road to the Natural Park of the Sierras de Cazorla, Segura and Las Villas, on a natural ledge from which magnificent panoramic views can be seen. It is located 200 meters from the village of La Iruela, 2 kilometers from the town of Cazorla and 20 minutes from Arroyo Frío. The complex is energetically and environmentally sustainable, since it uses biomass and efficient energy, and it consists of a 3-star Hotel



(Hotel Sierra de Cazorla & SPA 3*), a 4-star Hotel (Hotel & SPA Sierra de Cazorla 4*) and a Spa Center (Spa Óleo Salud) available for the guests of both hotels. It also has functional and shared services such as: reception, celebrating rooms, cafeteria, restaurants, a complimentary gym, parking and outdoor pool (open during the summer season). It also includes an apartment building located a short distance from the complex. The hotel's location allows for easily going on daytrips, by car or on foot (hiking, cycling).

ACEITES CAZORLA S.C.A. (CO-OP)

OLEOTUR Aceites Cazorla is an oil mill founded in 1951 and located in Cazorla, on the skirts of the Sierra de Cazorls. The olive groves belonging to the Picual and native Royal of Cazorla are certified by the Regulatory Board of the Cazorla Designation of Origin. The co-op has been recognized by the Regional Board of Jaen with the OLEOTUR JAÉN label as a tourable oil mill. It has an oil mill, a store, and tourable facilities.

RAFAEL ZABALETA MUSEUM (QUESADA)

The museum, at the heart of the Sierra of Cazorla, was opened in 2008 and it has a surface of 800 m2 divided on two floors. It hots a very significant part of the work of Rafael Zabaleta, renowned expressionist painter. born in Quesada. His work was clearly influenced by Picasso, a friend of his. His work is very baried, 114 oil paintings, 11 watercolours and 500 drawings, most of them being based on olive groves and their people. It representd very well all of his eras and influences.



The museum is complete with artworks of grandmasters of the 20th century, like Miró, Picasso, Tàpies, Canogar or Miralles, who paid homage after his passing by giving their artwork to the museum. Since 2021 a new space dedicated to the painter Jose Luis Verdes, who had a special relationship with Quesada, where he lived for ten years, has been opened.

MIGUEL HERNANDEZ & JOSEFINA MANRESA MUSEUM (QUESADA)



The bottom floor of the Rafael Zabaleta Museum building houses a big part of the legacy of **Miguel Hernández**, author of the "Andalusians of Jaén" poem. Its 553.85 m² surface offers a tour of the work and life of the poet and his wife, que Quesada-born Josefina Manresa, a love story full of passion and emotions, and goes over the life of the poet in 6 different rooms:

- **The Welcoming area**, which houses his main works and summarizes his life and work.
- The **"Perito en lunas"** room, which goes over his infancy and youth.
- The **"El Rayo que no cesa"** room, about his relationship with Josefina Manresa, his partner and poetic muse.
- The **"Viento del pueblo"** room, where the influence of the Spanish Civil War in his work is recreated. The famous poem "Aceituneros" (olive harvesters) was written in this era.
- The **"Cancionero y romancero de ausencias"** room, dedicated to his prison years, exhibits famous verses such as "Nanas de la cebolla" (onion nursery rhymes).
- The tour ends in the **"El legado del poeta"** room, a room for readings and workshops, where one can see the influence his work has had.

CIPAQ - INTERPRETATION CENTER FOR THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL HERITAGE OF QUESADA

Center about the Archaeological Heritage of the town of Quesada, including the set of Cultural Goods of Interest, with 22 caves that define the prehistoric map of the town, considered Unesco World Heritage, and the Roman Town of Bruñel.



It also has a space dedicated to the traditional games of the area, such as hopscotch, "serrano" bowling, etc.

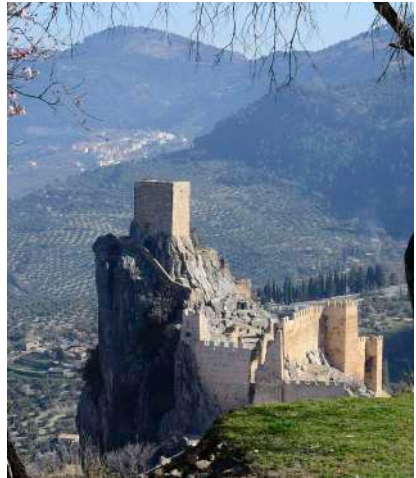


The artist Faustino Castillo Plaza (La Iruela, Jaén, 1957) has promoted a unique Mural Tour of the Olive Grove in the town of Peal de Becerro (Jaén), artistic creations that dress the old part of the town, due to the generosity of the neighbours who offered their walls to house this murals.

OLIVE GROVE LANDSCAPES

La Iruela Castle

La Iruela: Its old town was declared Historic and Artistic Heritage in 2013. Located as an excellent viewpoint of the sea of olive trees, 932 metres above sea level, it features white houses and its location, at the foot of the rocky hill El Escribano. The town is located on the same rock and around the fortress, surrounded by the typical urban landscape of La Iruela, sloped and narrow streets, small white houses, and balconies with pots and vines. The typical landscape is a fusion of olive and pine trees.

TOWER OF INFANTE DON ENRIQUE, IN TÍSCAR (QUESADA)

The tower of Infante Don Enrique, also known as the Tower of The Port of Tíscar, or the Castle Tower fo Figue, was built in the 14th century by Infante Don Enrique, and it is located in the highest and most strategic point of the Port of Tíscar (previously known as the Ausín Port), 1,189 metres above sea level.



From the top of this watchtower one can see the Castles of Tíscar and Quesada, the plains of Pozo Alcón, Sierra Nevada, and the valleys of the Extremera, Béjar and Majuela rivers, up to the towns of Úbeda, Baeza, Torreperogil, Santo Tomé, Villacarrillo and Iznatoraf.
