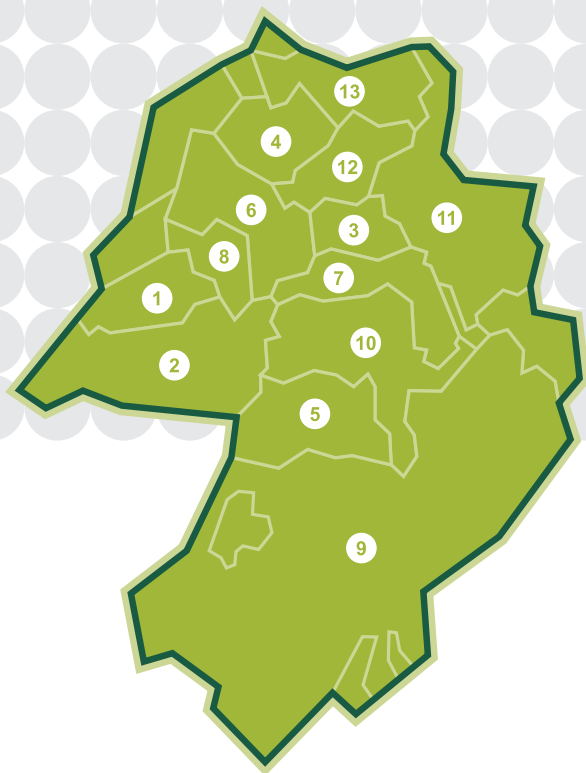

The region of the **Sierra de Segura** is located in the northeastern part of the province of Jaén and is a typical mountain area, which is a determining factor for the maintenance of its traditional culture and its natural resources.

The natural wealth of the Sierra de Segura and the adjoining Sierras de Cazorla and Las Villas, deserved the declaration of Natural Park, being the largest Protected Natural Area in Spain. A territory declared a Biosphere Reserve by Unesco and a special protection area for birds, thus forming part of the whole region of the Natura 2000 Network. To enjoy and discover impressive nature trails among its abundance of water and its rich fauna, in the diversity of a landscape in which the pine forest meets the olive grove.

In this framework, customs, art and gastronomy have been maintained; with a wide variety and quality of traditional cured meats and Serrano hams, the region is also the cradle of the renowned sheep breed of the Segureño lamb. It is essential to taste recipes of typical dishes and sweets, where its rich olive oil has always been present.

An exquisite Virgin Olive Oil, with the typical characteristics of the Mountain Olive grove, being in its day the first D.O. granted in Andalusia: D.O. Sierra de Segura, pioneer in organic olive oil.

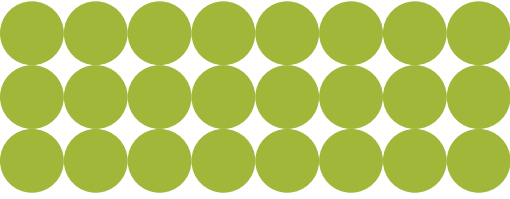

OLEAÍ – BEAS DE SEGURA

Oleaí is a group formed by organic farmers committed to environmental conservation and social and economic development of the Sierra de Segura de Jaén, members of the Association of Producers and Consumers Segura Ecológica, which seeks the sustainable development of the region.



The Sierra de Segura and its olive groves are part of the Natura 2000 Network (European ecological network of biodiversity conservation areas), committed to maintaining the vegetation cover of the countryside. They protect the biodiversity of the Sierra de Segura and contribute to the reduction of the carbon footprint, through the living olive groves project to which they belong.



Oleai oil is obtained from the picual olive harvest. Its EVOO First Harvest Day has won several international awards, repeating *Extragold* medal for the third consecutive year in the BIOL awards. The BIOL international award is the world's largest competition for organic extra virgin olive oils.

The event offers a comparison of the best Organic Extra Virgin Olive Oils from different continents, organized by Consorzio il Biologico Società Cooperativa, where more than 500 oils from 30 countries are presented.

OLEOFER – LA PUERTA DE SEGURA

Oleofer is one of the most important oil mills in the Sierra de Segura region. It was founded in 1952 as "Agrolea" together with other partners in La Puerta de Segura (Jaén).

In 1987 it bought the entire Almazara La Moderna.

In 2009 it acquires Finca Los Barrancos, thus closing the circle in a process in which the entire production of Extra Virgin Olive Oil is controlled, from harvesting to packaging and subsequent marketing and export.

In 2012, an organic milling line was launched and the Tierras de Tavera brand was launched with its three lines of business: oil, gourmet olives and organic products.

In 2014 it was consolidated as the first oil mill in the Sierra de Segura specialized in oleoturismo.

Oro de la Puerta is an oil production company, in agreement with the mills "Potosí" and "Tierra de Tavara"-Integrated Production Agriculture of the Sierra de Segura region. It is located in La Puerta de Segura and was born from the dream of creating a different type of agriculture, traditional and organic. Without losing what previous generations have transmitted, they try to improve with their own means, always respecting the environment. They are characterized by using neither pesticides nor pesticides, adding a natural biological pest control such as insect hotels and bee hives. They use ladybugs as natural predators and bees as pollinators, in charge of pest control in the olive grove. They have different qualities of AOVEs in addition to the seal of quality D.O. Sierra de Segura. They have a centenary mountain olive grove surrounded by pine and rosemary trees, cared for and pampered down to the last detail by natural and sustainable means. Their products range from the most select EVOO'S (extra virgin olive oils), through the early harvest oils of the Picual variety to their more economical selection oils.

Cortijo La Zarza is a company located in Arroyo del Ojanco that is dedicated to the production and marketing of Extra Virgin Olive Oil PREMIUM, focusing on the highest quality of the final product.

It is an environmentally friendly brand that combines the minimal use of plastic in its packaging, all of which is recyclable, with the

cultivation and harvesting in a traditional olive grove farm, which produces an Extra Virgin Olive Oil of the highest quality.

Cortijo La Zarza represents a place of the same name located in the municipality of Arroyo del Ojanco, in Jaén. A small production of traditional olive groves in fincas bathed by the Guadalimar River, straddling the Sierra Morena and the Sierra de Segura.

"Cortijo La Zarza" is available in a 500 Ml. format in a can, which helps the correct conservation of the olive oil and a 5 liter format packaged in a traditional glass container. It has an establishment and offers visits to the olive grove.

SIERRA DE GÉNAVE SCA

Sierra de Génave is a Cooperative Society dedicated exclusively to the production, bottling and marketing of organic extra virgin olive oil, certified by the C.A.A.E. (Andalusian Committee of Organic Agriculture).

Its olive mill, located on the outskirts of the municipality of Génave, is part of the Natural Park of the Sierras de Cazorla, Segura and Las Villas, the largest protected area in Spain, whose environmental characteristics have earned it the recognition of Biosphere Reserve.

Its organically grown oil is optimal for health and provides maximum intensity in flavor and a greater vitamin intake. Founded in

1989, it is a pioneer in the cultivation of organic olive groves, and currently has more than 100 members and about 2,000 hectares of production. Its organic oil reaches the main national and international markets.

100% of the production is sold packaged, which provides added value that stays in the production area. The objective of Sierra de Génave SCA is to achieve the maximum





quality, regardless of the quantity. This entails applying specific techniques in the cultivation, as well as in the harvesting and transport of the olives and in the milling and packaging processes.
