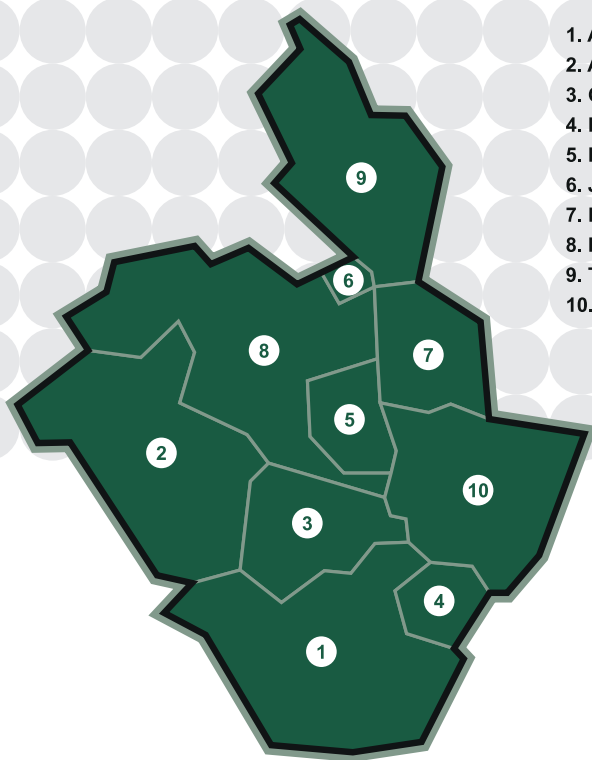

The **Sierra Sur de Jaén** region is located in the south of the province of Jaén, between the Sub-Baetic mountain range and the Guadalquivir depression. It has always been a melting pot of cultures and civilizations, which have marked its unique personality and landscape. full of a rich natural, historic, cultural and ethnic heritage.

Its strategic location as a frontier between Christian and Muslim territories in times past, gave rise to an impassable defensive system of castles, watchtowers and towers of castles, of which there are still abundant and valuable testimonies today.

But in the Sierra Sur de Jaén there is much more. From the olive grove countryside to the rugged mountains, from the orchards, vineyards and cherry trees to its sky certified as a Starlight Reserve, a privileged place for astrotourism. Biodiversity and nature intermingle with an enormous tangible and intangible and immaterial olive growing heritage where olive trees and olive groves are part of the ancestral culture of these lands.

Among the gastronomic jewels of the Sierra Sur de Jaén are the dishes made with products from the orchards and extensive livestock farming, washed down with magnificent olive oils. This land of contrasts produces extra virgin olive oils of great quality, harmony and complexity. The Picual variety predominates, with other varieties being significant, such as the Picuda and the Carrasqueño de Alcaudete.

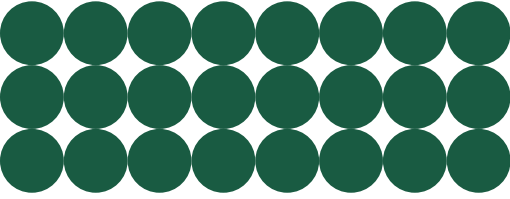

S.C.A, OLEOCAMPO

Oleocampo is a second-degree co-op formed by a packaging plant of AOVES and five production centers; San Bartolomé, Santa Catalina and La Unión de Torredelcampo, Consolación de Torredonjimeno and San Francisco de Asís de Villardompardo. The production centers of which Oleocampo is a part were formed by small and medium-sized groups of olive growers. Until then, and getting lost in the times, the farmers used to mill the olives in private mills. The launching of these co-ops is the first step to integrate the efforts of farmers in a common goal, achieving year after year to increase the number of members and in turn the volume of exploitation of extra virgin olive oil.

Located all of them in the Southern Countryside of Jaén, among their olive groves, many of them centenary, the oil of the highest quality is produced and cared for by its 3,472 members, cultivating 10,812 hectares of olive groves, the vast majority of which are rainfed and of the picual variety.

Interpretation Center belonging to the Regional Network of Olive Oil Mills and Olive Oil Tourism dedicated to olive oil and nutrition. Located in the facilities of Oleocampo and promoted by ADSUR.



LA BAÑIZUELA- TORREDELCAMPO FOREST



The Natural Monument Bosque de la Bañizuela is characterized by its uniqueness as an island forest in which the Mediterranean sclerophyllous forest is perfectly represented and, despite its small size and being located in a dry ombroclimate, it has a large number of species of unique beauty, typical of sub-humid climates.

It has a small area of 2.32 ha in which you can see gall oaks and an undergrowth formed by durillo, oleander, kermes oak, yellow jasmine, honeysuckle, and the interesting legume called espantalobos.

RÍO FRÍO - LOS VILLARES LANDSCAPE

The Río Frío site is located about 7 km from Los Villares and at an altitude of over a thousand meters.

It collects the water that drains the Sierra de la Pandera forming the source of the river. Riverside vegetation, crystal clear waters and a recreational area to relax with the sound of water in the shadows.



OPTION 1

LANDSCAPE AND NATURE TOUR THROUGH VALDEPEÑAS DE JAÉN

“Las Chorreras”

One of the most representative resources of the Sierra de Valdepeñas is the abundance of water. Being the protagonist of “Las Chorreras”, it stands out in this space for descending with bravura, resting in small pools and falling by beautiful waterfalls; the largest of them about 20 meters high. “Las Chorreras” runs along a very steep natural ravine where the erosion of the river on the limestone pierces the rock, creating the path that allows us to run through it. In the place there is a small recreational area, suitable for a pleasant picnic, with barbecues and tables, ideal for summer days.



“Sierra de la Pandera”

Valdepeñas de Jaén is located in a quite mountainous region where high peaks such as Ventisqueros (1763m), Cerro de la Cruz (1722m) or Pandera (1872m) stand out. The latter is considered the roof of the Sierra Sur de Jaén, with its 1872 meters high. It offers spectacular views of the Quebrajano, Jaén capital, Mágina, Cazorla and even Sierra Nevada. For hiking enthusiasts, the trail that

starts from the Puerto de las Coberteras, passing through the Puerto de la Nava and the Peña del Altar to the top of the Pandera, is one of the most beautiful of the Sierra Sur.

Navalayegua viewpoint and “Quejigo del Carbón”

It is a strategic natural viewpoint, located at 1,500 meters of altitude, from which you can obtain magnificent views of the Quebrajano reservoir and the Sierra Sur. In its surroundings, a well-preserved typical Mediterranean forest, we find the “Quejigo del Carbón”, a thousand-year-old gall oak declared a Natural Monument.





“Pítillos”

Declared a Natural Monument, "Pítillos" is a rugged relief around a small valley -that of the Queibrajano River- surrounded by three elevations of more than 1,200 meters. The presence of narrow canyons, up to 30 meters high, in the course of the Queibrajano River is noteworthy.

OPTION 2 MUSEUM MILLOF SANTA ANA - VALDEPEÑAS DE JAÉN

The Santa Ana Mill is the first known mill in the town of Valdepeñas de Jaén. It is a traditional flour mill of rodezno, which continues to operate as the first day since its construction in the sixteenth century, specifically on August 15, 1540. Juanín LeClerque was the one who recovered the mill in 1540, one year after his arrival to the municipality, and he and the rest of his family members worked in the mill until 1904. After the conquest of Granada, the Sierra Sur began to be populated taking advantage of the



land where the Arabs had left canal systems and irrigation ditches. At the end of the 19th century there were numerous mills in the town, among them the Molino del Estanquillo, Fuente de los Chorros, Molinillo, Veredón and Chircales. In 1921 is when Jacinto Parra Martínez, a miller by profession, acquired the mill and from then on it became the property of the family, which continues to this day.

Today, the building houses a museum. The most interesting area of the mill is the one that houses the machinery. It is occupied by two cárcavos, hollows in the rock where the impellers rotate. Above the cárcavos is the milling room. You will also find the cleaning room, where you can see the machinery for cleaning and washing the wheat.

OPTION 3 SKY OBSERVATION OF THE STARLIGHT RESERVE SIERRA SUR DE JAÉN IN SIERRA DE LA PANDERA



In 2014 the Sierra Sur de Jaén was certified as a Starlight Reserve, the first in Andalusia. A certification that guarantees the existence of night skies with magnificent conditions for the observation of the firmament. Currently the region is part of the Astronomical Corridor of Jaén, a network of protected natural areas where a commitment to the defense of the quality of the night sky and access to starlight is established. In this sense, the Sierra de la Pandera is a fantastic place to enjoy the night sky and the Starlight Reserve.

The mill was established in 1960, has 702 members and an olive grove area of 2,888.17 hectares, with an average production of 13,500,000 kilos of olives and 3,000,000 kilos of oil. From the traditional pressing system that was installed in its beginnings, the cooperative has undergone different transformations until reaching its current state, where the latest technology in oil reception, extraction and storage is installed. In the same way, the quality of the oil has been evolving with the new consumer demand. They have moved from the traditional packaging of Extra Virgin Olive Oil "Peña de Martos" to the path of excellence, with the brand "TUCCIOLIVA". Since 2007 Tuccioliva is among the most prestigious and awarded in the best competitions, both nationally and internationally, being the first co-op in the province of Jaén involved in a high quality project.

CORTIJO EL MADROÑO- MARTOS

Cortijo El Madroño is located among a sea of olive trees in Martos. Built in the 19th century in the middle of the Nasrid route, near Jaen and halfway between Cordoba and Granada. It has an outstanding oil mill and its museum where the evolution of the processes of production of the liquid gold through history is offered together with a unique landscape, the best miller's breakfast, a tasting of different types of oil, equestrian or flamenco shows and a delicious lunch or dinner. These attributes, among others, offer the visitor a multitude of possibilities to make olive oil tourism a unique experience that will not leave you indifferent.

OPTION 1 ROUTE OF THE CENTENARY OLIVE TREES OF MARTOS.

To speak of Martos is to speak of the cradle of the olive grove and of the municipality that has been, historically, the first producer of olive oil in the world, with an average harvest of around 50 million kilos of olives. The more than 20,000 hectares of its municipal area are conquered by the olive monoculture and, especially, by the scenic beauty of its majestic centenary olive trees. It is a traditional olive grove with an oil of the picual variety.



In Martos, where there are approximately 1,500,000 olive trees, more than 60% of them are more than 200 years old, although oral tradition has shown that the olive trees in the area of Llano de Motril are more than half a century old. This route of the centenary olive trees occupies an extension of 84 hectares, with 5,394 trees as a whole, some of them true living sculptures that are capable of providing an average production per tree of 150 kilos.

OPTION 2

BIKE RIDE ALONG THE OLIVE OIL GREEN WAY



The Olive Oil Greenway is presented as a new and attractive offer of inland tourism based on the use and recovery of the old abandoned railroad Jaén - Campo Real (Córdoba) as a green corridor, ideal for the practice of cycling, hiking and other sports in direct contact with nature. Built between 1882 and 1893, this railway belongs to the Linares - Puente Genil line, which was dedicated throughout much of the twentieth century to the transport of various metals from the mines of Linares and, especially,

to the transfer of the olive oil produced in the region, it was popularly known as the "Tren del Aceite" (Olive Oil Train).

Technical and commercial reasons led to its abandonment in 1971, and it was definitively closed to the transport of passengers and goods on January 1, 1985, when it was dismantled.

The Greenway can be enjoyed along its 128 km in various ways. Among them, by bicycle, starting from Martos among centenary olive groves.

OPTION 3

HISTORICAL-CULTURAL HERITAGE OF MARTOS.

Martos is an important city that sits at the foot of the Cerro de la Peña, crowned by the remains of the castle of the same name, along whose slope extends the compact urban center, presided over by the Castillo de la Villa and the great Church of Santa Maria. From this privileged location you can see its lands populated by an immense sea of olive trees.



In the interior there are interesting monuments such as the Church of Santa María de la Villa, the Church of the Trinitarias, the Church of San Francisco, the Hermitage of San Bartolomé, the Church of San Amador and Santa Ana, the Pilar de la Fuente Nueva, the Hospital of San Juan de Dios, the Real Iglesia Parroquial de Santa Marta, the Chapel of Our Father Jesus and the Old Jail and Cabildo.

ALCALÁ OLIVE OIL MUSEUM - ALCALÁ LA REAL

The Olive Oil Museum is easily accessed from the main road, about 3 km outside of Alcalá la Real.

The mill dates back to 1914 and was completely restored by Alcalá Oliva in 2015. Visitors will have the opportunity to feel its authenticity and the beauty of a bygone era and will discover the history of the olive plant, the classification of olive oil, its varieties and the production process. The visit also includes a real olive picking experience (depending on the period), an oil tasting session or a longer stop for a typical breakfast or lunch.

CASTLE FORTRESS OF LA MOTA- ALCALÁ LA REAL.



The Mota Fortress is much more than just a castle. Whoever approaches it will be able to learn about the concept of frontier and the ways of life derived from that situation. The system of walls, the cisterns, its streets, squares and houses, together with the Abbey Church, the old Town Hall and the military citadel, serve as guides for a journey through time in which to learn about the life and customs of a walled city in the late Middle Ages.

For more than 150 years, Alcalá became a strategic point on the northern border with the Kingdom of Granada. A space of contact between two worlds, sometimes at odds with each other. It was a complex and dangerous territory, difficult to defend, dotted with countless fortified constructions, distributed on both sides of the border.

La Mota has a complex system of walls; three belts that surrounded it starting from the high part of the hill, in the surroundings of the alcazaba, until reaching the limits of the Old suburb.

From the hill of La Mota, the "mountain of Andalusia", as it was called in the times of the Catholic Monarchs, there is a wide perspective over Granada territory and it is not surprising the effort of both the Nasrid kingdom to maintain this advanced strategic position and the permanent attempt of its conquest by the Castilian kings to weaken the Arab power of Granada.

In this impressive fortress, supported by a belt of watchtowers distributed throughout the territory, was located not only one of the most complex defensive systems of Al-Andalus, the





but also a model Muslim city with a citadel, residential area and commercial area, complete with an outer enclosure. La Mota was the last great defensive bastion before accessing Granada, from Jaen and Cordoba, so its conquest was not easy for Castile. In 1213, for the first time, Alfonso VIII took it from the Almohads. After the Christian conquest in the early thirteenth

century, the precious fortress of La Mota, fell back into Arab power until, in 1341, Alfonso XI finally made it capitulate. In 1931 the Mota, with its fortress and abbey church, was declared a National Monument and, in 1967, Alcalá la Real was declared a Historic-Artistic Site.

HISTORICAL SITE - ALCALÁ LA REAL



At the foot of the famous Fortaleza de la Mota and the surrounding walls, lies the city of Alcalá la Real, with its urban structure of Arab origin, its steep streets, full of surprises, stately homes, churches and architectural details, samples of its splendor and its rich historical past. The Church of Consolación, the Church of Santo Domingo, the Church of Nuestra Señora de las Angustias, the Church of San Juan Bautista, the Palacio Abacial, the Town Hall and the Fuente del Pilar de los Álamos are examples of this.

From the viewpoint in the neighborhood of Las Cruces, visitors can enjoy a magnificent view of Alcalá la Real and its ancient fortified city.

OPTION 1 WINE TOURISM VISIT - BODEGAS MARCELINO SERRANO - ALCALÁ LA REAL.



The winery and vineyards are located on a plateau two kilometers from Alcalá la Real, Paraje del Cascante, with extraordinary views of the Sierra Sur de Jaén and the Fuente del Rey Valley.

The winery and vineyards are spectacularly integrated into the landscape, in which a magnificent Christian watchtower called Torre del Cascante stands out. Own vineyards with an experimental field of quality varieties, cabernet-sauvignon, tempranillo, graciano, garnacha, syrah, pinot noir, merlot, chardonnay, garnacha blanca and moscatel, etc, which vinified separately and blended at convenience produce structured and very fruity wines that result in excellent signature wines.

The guided tours by Marcelino Serrano and Blanca María Serrano offer experiences in Viticulture and Oenology. History of wine in the city, importance of the vine in the Middle Ages, Privileges of wine by Queen Joanna of Castile and her son Charles V, grape varieties, fermentation, etc..

Visits can be for any person at any age range, from couples to groups of 25 people by appointment. For groups they also organize typical gastronomic meals of our area such as a "arroz caldoso".

CORTIJO EL TOBAZO - ACEITES SOLER ROMERO - ALCAUDETE

Soler Romero is a family company located in Alcaudete, with an extensive olive growing tradition. They produce, bottle and distribute organic extra virgin olive oil, processing only the olives grown on the farm. They are one of the few organic olive farms with full traceability in Spain: SOLER ROMERO organic extra virgin olive oil is made exclusively with olives from their olive groves, the olives are processed in the mill and the bottling is also carried out in the same facilities.

The farm, called Cortijo El Tobazo, has belonged to the family since 1850 and 6 generations have been in charge of its exploitation. The first plot was acquired by the matriarch of the family, Doña Casilda, in the middle of the 19th century. An agreement was made with local shepherds to graze in exchange for planting the olive trees. The olive trees are centuries old and most of them were planted by those shepherds almost 200 years ago.



They participate in the Olivares Vivos project coordinated by SEO Birdlife, together with other partners such as the Diputación de Jaén, the Departments of Ecology and Marketing of the University of Jaén and the Experimental Station of Arid Zones of the Higher Council for Scientific Research.

OPTION 1 CALATRAVO DE ALCAUDETE CASTLE

It was the year 711 when the Muslims entered the Peninsula and began the conquest of what was called Al-Andalus, reaching as far as the Duero and Ebro valleys. However, around the year 1030, their power weakened so much that the Christian kings began an offensive to recover the conquered lands. Thus a powerful defensive system was created to prevent the recovery of the lands by the Muslims, based on a wide range of large castles, watchtowers and fortresses, as is the case of the Castle of Alcaudete.



The Castle of Alcaudete was part of the defense belt that King Ferdinand III the Saint entrusted for the protection of the western border of the Kingdom of Jaén against the Nasrid kingdom of Granada. It was built between the XIII and XIV centuries. This castle has had several stages throughout its life, which have impregnated its walls with legends and stories, memories and adventures, which have left their mark on its structure and that make the monumental complex possess a unique beauty that does not leave its visitors indifferent.

OPTION 2

SOURCE OF THE RIVER SAN JUAN - CASTLE OF LOCUBIN

The source of the San Juan River is located very close to the town of Castillo de Locubín, just four kilometers in the direction of Valdepeñas de Jaén, and is formed by the depression between the hills of La Serrezuela and La Nava.

It is a green lung and has a recreational area. It represents a magnificent enclave to spend a pleasant day in the countryside surrounded by nature, enjoying a swim in the ponds, resting under the dense grove or taking a hiking trail.

It is a place of great beauty, where several pools of crystalline water have formed naturally, from which the subway water flows forming beautiful and intermittent columns of bubbles to the surface, in addition, we can observe small waterfalls and canals.

The surroundings of the source of the San Juan river are characterized by a typically Mediterranean landscape, with holm oaks and kermes oaks as protagonists. Other plants present are the mastic tree, the white jara, the thyme and the rosemary, but undoubtedly the white poplar is the most abundant species next to the source and the bank of the river. All along the banks of the river San Juan we can observe fertile orchards that make up the "Vega Castellera", which acquires its maximum splendor in spring with the flowering of the cherry trees, very abundant in the area, watered from the same pools of the source through a channel known as "el caz". The temperature of the water, too cold, does not allow the life of fish, although sometimes trout from the repopulations carried out by the fishing clubs arrive at the source. Among the fauna, there are birds, mainly associated with the rocky areas, which are very frequent in this area of the sierra, as well as the area of the sierra. Thus, the black wheatear, the wren, the solitary rock thrush or the eagle owl nest in the area.

The source of water for centuries has supplied all the cultures that have passed through these lands. Iberians as well as Romans took advantage of its fresh waters for cultivation and consumption.

OPTION 3 VIA FERRATA – LOCUBIN CASTLE

The via ferrata of Castillo de Locubín, starts a few meters from the Nacimiento del Río San Juan, crossing this mountain range from the base of the road to its summit. The via ferrata has a length of about 700 meters and during its route we find a Tibetan bridge and a handrail that provide adrenaline and fun. The approximate length for its realization is three hours.



The route is open all year round and no previous experience is necessary to enjoy high-altitude hiking. It is an activity that allows the public to enjoy the sensation of emptiness that climbing provides. It is divided into three areas where the route is made up of vertical and inclined sections, traverse and vertical areas on rock.

Along the ferrata we will find three bridges, a Nepalese bridge (with the possibility of escape on the left of about 20m and without life line), a 7m monkey bridge (with which we can finish the ferrata or continue by the new extension (made in 2017) and another monkey bridge by which we will ascend in search of the end of the new section. The effort will be rewarded with a unique perspective of this beautiful natural landscape.
